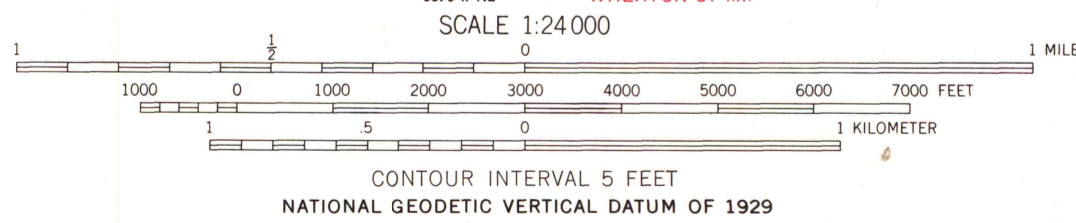
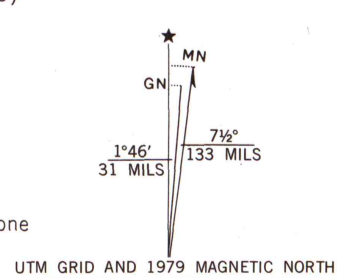


Mapped, edited, and published by the Geological Survey North Dakota area mapped in cooperation with State of North Dakota, Water Commission Control by USGS and USCGS

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grids based on Minnesota coordinate system, central zone and North Dakota coordinate system, south zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 14, shown in blue
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 7 meters north and 27 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked
