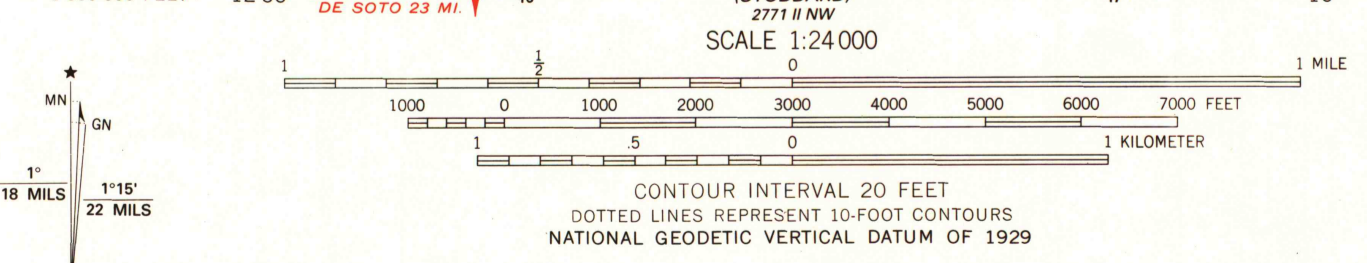

There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map. Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.
