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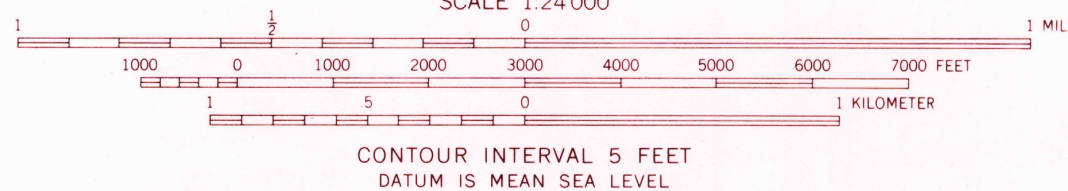

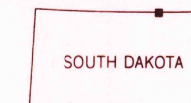
UTM GRID AND 1968 MAGNETIC NORTH DECLINATION AT CENTER OF SHEET
