





## Topographic Map Symbols

Primary highway, hard surface Secondary highway, hard surface . Light-duty road, hard or improved surface . Unimproved road; trail . . . Route marker: Interstate; U. S.; State Railroad: standard gage; narrow gage . Bridge; drawbridge ... Built-up area: only selected landmark buildings shown .

Fence or field line ... Dam; dam with lock .

Windmill; water well; spring . . Control: horizontal station; vertical station; spot elevation

Mine shaft; prospect; adit or cave . Distorted surface: strip mine, lava; sand . . Sounding; depth curve ...

Contours: index; intermediate; supplementary; depression Perennial lake and stream; intermittent lake and stream . Rapids, large and small; falls, large and small . Swamp; marsh . .

Woodland; scattered trees . .
